

February 6, 2017

The Marion township board of zoning appeals held its regularly scheduled meeting on February 6, 2017. Members present for the meeting were Tim Combs, Charles Dilsaver, Todd Hunt, and Cindy Rinker.

Member absent was Ted Babich, all other members were present. Also present for the hearing were James Stover and Charles Fosnaugh.

Vice Chairwoman Rinker called the meeting to order by asking for the reading of the January meeting minutes. Charles Dilsaver made a motion to accept the minutes as read and Todd Hunt seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as read.

Vice chairwoman Rinker then asked for the James Stover hearing. Mr. Stover is requesting: 1. A conditional Use permit to construct a storage unit. He would like to build 1 unit, 10,000 in square footage sometime in mid-summer. He is also requesting a variance to erect 3 two sided billboards. The 10 feet X 40 feet boards will be 500 feet apart on route 23, north of Marion Williamsport Road. Tim Combs made a motion to approve the conditional Use permit for the storage units and the variance for the billboards. Todd Hunt seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Tim Combs – yes, Charles Dilsaver – yes, Todd Hunt – yes, and Cindy Rinker – yes. The motion was approved.

Vice Chairwoman Rinker then asked for any old or new business. As there was not any other old or new business to discuss. Charles Dilsaver made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Todd Hunt seconded the motion. The next meeting is scheduled for March 6, 2017 at 7 PM.
