

**MARION TOWNSHIP ZONING COMMISSION
PUBLIC HEARING**

August 2, 2018

A public hearing before the Marion Township Zoning Commission was held on Thursday, August 2, 2018, at 1228 East Fairground Street, Marion, Ohio, the same having been advertised in the July 19, 2018, edition of The Marion Star. The purpose of the public hearing was to consider the application of Junior Bentley and Diana Stansbery for property 2061 Marion-Green Camp Road, Marion, Ohio, being approximately 2.497 acres from A-1 to B-2.

Meeting called to order by Chairperson, Marilyn Smith.

Members present: Marilyn Smith, Mauri Morse, Denny Smith, Clancey DeVore, Gerald Wade and Secretary, Jennifer Sidle. Guests present: Marion Township Zoning Inspector, Lynn Clabaugh, Junior Bentley and Robert Morris with Marion County Regional Planning Commission.

Mr. Bentley presented the rezoning application. The reason for the rezoning to allow the applicant to move his used car lot to his residence.

Marion County Regional Planning Commission's report did not recommend the rezoning of the property. Mr. Morris presented the Staff Report for Marion County Regional Planning Commission.

A roll call vote was taken for the approval or the denial of the rezoning request as follows: Mr. Morse "yes"; Mr. Smith "yes"; Mr. Wade "yes"; Mr. DeVore "no"; and Ms. Smith "no". The Commission's recommendation to approve the rezoning request will be communicated to the Board of Trustees for its action.
